PRIVACY POLICY

Your personal information will be treated strictly in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and the 'private sector amendments' contained in the Privacy Amendment (Private Sector) Act 2000 (Cth).

We may use this information for internal or marketing purposes and we may provide some information to credit reference agencies or service providers to confirm your credit rating. We may record telephone conversations between you and persons working for us. Such recordings, or transcripts from such recordings, may be used to resolve any dispute between you and AUGS.

AUGS' website uses cookies. A cookie is a small amount of data which often includes a unique identification number or value that is sent to your browser from a website's computer and stored on your computer's hard drive. This information is used to evaluate and improve the performance of our websites. We do not collect any information about you through our website unless you provide the information to us.
